



Questions Ranchers should ask Agencies Concerning Permits

Not all of these questions may need to be asked, they are to help keep you aware and involved in the permit process before any escalation begins.

Questions to ask if you are a permittee-

- 1.) What kind of monitoring are you doing in my allotment?
- 2.) What kind of inventory are you doing in my allotment?
- 3.) When are you going to start working on permit renewals and gathering data?
- 4.) What alternatives are you going to be analyzing?
- 5.) If I want to submit an alternative for the permit renewal when do I need to submit it?
- 6.) If I want to do any range improvements, what do I need to do to get it approved in a NEPA document?
- 7.) If I want to do monitoring what type will the agencies accept?
- 8.) By allotment, what issues or concerns have been identified by ID team members and interested public?

** Tell the agency that **you** want to be involved in the scoping procedures and gathering of information/data.

*** If you are not getting answers, writing a letter will formalize issues and you may get a better response.
