GRASS:



Hollow, jointed stems
Parallel veination
Leaves on two sides
of the stem



A grass flower
"floret"



FORBS:

"Wildflowers and Weeds"

Showy
flowers



Leaves
netted
veination



Solid stems,
but not woody

GRASS-LIKES:

"Looks like a grass, but isn't"

SEDGES



Solid stems

Leaves on
three sides

RUSHES



Leaves on
two sides

SHRUBS:

Solid
woody
stems



Often
producing berries

Leaf veins
are net-like
