ORDER CREATING HERD DISTRICT

This matter came on regularly for hearing on April 8th, 1957, at the Minidoka County Courthouse in Rupert, Minidoka County, Idaho, before the Board of County Commissioners of said county and state, upon Petition for the Creation of Herd District, and after Notice of Hearing published and posted as provided by law.

The Board of County Commissioners being satisfied that a majority of the land owners owning more than fifty percent of the land in the Herd District herein created, and being resident in and qualified electors of the state of Idaho are in favor of the enforcement of the herd law in said Herd District, and being further satisfied that it would be beneficial to such Herd District -

IT IS ORDERED that a Herd District be and the same hereby is created in Minidoka County, Idaho, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the NE corner of Section 36 in Township 7 South of Range 25 EBM; Thence West 1 mile; South $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; West 1 mile; North $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; West $\frac{1}{2}$ miles; South 1 mile; West about $17\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the NW corner of Section 6 in Township 8 South of Range 22 EBM on the Minidoka-Jerome County line; thence South about $15\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the Snake River; thence Easterly along said Snake River about 3 miles to the SE corner of Section 16 in Township 10 South of Range 22 EBM; thence North about 5 miles to the NW corner of Section 27 in Township 9 south of Range 22 EBM; thence East 1 mile; North 1 mile; East 1 mile; North 1 mile; East 1 mile; North 1 mile; thence East about $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the SE corner of Section 3 in Township 9 South of Range 23 EBM; thence North 1 mile, East 2 miles, North 1 mile; East $5\frac{1}{2}$ miles; North 1 mile; East $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles; South $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; East 3 miles; thence North 6 miles to the place of beginning, containing the following parcels of land:

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

BE IT REMEMBERED, That the Board of County Commissioners met this 9th day of July pursuant to recess of June 28th, 1920.

WHEREUPON the following proceedings were had to wit:

The Board proceeded to equalize the 1920 assessment rolls.

In the matter of the Heyburn Milling assessment was taken up, invoices, etc. submitted, and it appearing that \$4,000.00 was a fair bases, it was regularly ordered that valuation of said property be fixed at \$4,000.00.

In the matter of the assessment of the Project Mutual Telephone Co; it appearing that said property was exempt as provided for in subdivision 18 Sec. 3099 complied Statutes, it was regularly ordered that exemption be granted.

The stock of Merchandise in building located on Lot 4, Block 47, Rupert was filed at \$8375.00, being the original valuation placed by the assessor. It appearing that no further complaint had been filed and the work of equalizing the assessment rolls having been completed the Board adjourned, and immediately convened as a Regular Board whereupon the following proceedings were had:

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF A. McKenzie AND OTHERS
FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF A HERD DISTRICT:

The Petitions of A. McKenzie and others for the creation of a herd district within the county of Minidoka in the State of Idaho comprising that portion of the Minidoka Reclamation Project on the northerly side of Snake River coming on this day regularly to be heard pursuant to order of June 23rd, 1920, fixing this date for the hearing of said petition, and it appearing that notice of the hearing of said petition had been given in the manner and for the period required by law and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board of county commissioners that the said petitions are signed by a majority of the qualified electors residing within the boundaries set forth in said petitions and that a majority of the electors within said boundaries are in favor of the enforcement of the herd law therein and of preventing all animals of the species of horses, mules, asses, cattle, swine, sheep and goats from running at large during any and all periods of the year and from being herded on the highways within the said boundaries and it appearing it would be for the benefit and advantage of the territory embraced within the boundaries of said proposed herd district that the herd law be enforced therein;

IT IS ORDERED That a herd district be, and it is hereby created in accordance with the prayer ~~for~~ of the petition and that, during any and all periods of the year all animals of the species of horses, mules, assesses, cattle, swine, sheep and goats be and they are hereby prohibited from running at large within the territory embraned within the boundaries in said petition and hereinafter set forth and from being

herded on the highways in said territory; that the boundaries of said herd district be and the same are hereby, fixed as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the north bank of Lake Walcott with the township line between townships 25 and 26 east of the Boise Meridian, thence north approximately one and one-half miles to the northeast corner of Section 36, Township 8 South of Range 25 E. B. M., thence west three miles, thence north one-half mile, thence west three and one-half miles, thence south one-half mile, thence west five and one-half miles, thence south one mile, thence west two miles, thence south one mile, thence west to the northwest corner of Section 7, in Township 9 South of Range 23 E. B. M. thence south one mile, thence west one mile, thence south one mile, thence west one mile, thence south one mile, thence west one mile, thence south to the North bank of Snake River, thence in a general northeasterly direction along the north bank of said Snake River to the place of beginning.

And including all of Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36, and south-half of Sections 28, 29, and 30 in Township 8 South of Range 25 E. B. M. and the Southeast quarter of Section 36, and all of Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36 Township 8 South of Range Twenty four (24 East of the Boise Meridian, all of Township 9 South of Range 23 E. B. M. except sections 3, 4, 5, and 6. Sections 13, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 34, 35, 36, township 9 South of Range 22, E. B. M. all of Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15, and that part of Sections 22, 23, and 24, north of Snake River in Township 10 South of Range 22 E. B. M., and all of the following township north of Snake River, to-wit: Township 10 South of Range 23, E. B. M., and Townships 9 and 10 South of Range 24 E. B. M. and Township 9 South of Range 25 E. B. M.

This order shall be in full force and effect from and after the 10th day of August, 1920.

The Board of County Commissioners ordered that the Engineer, McDonough, proceed at once to repair the Milner Bridge across Snake River in accordance with the engineers report, at the expense of both counties, with the consent of the Commissioners of Twin Falls County.

In the matter of the petition of A. W. Clyde and twenty eight others asking that the Board create a herd district, to wit:

SECTIONS four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeed, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, tewnty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three, twenty-four, twenty-five, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twenty-nine and thirty of township seven (7) South, Range twenty five (25) East Boise Meridian. The matter came on regularly for hearing this 10 A. M., May 9, 1914, at the regular adjourned meeting of said Board, said time and date being the time and date set by the said Board according to law for the hearing of said petition at which time and place any person may show cause why the said petition should not be granted;

After hearing the arguments on behalf of the petitioners and all remonstrance against said petition; and it appearing to the Board that the necessary notice of such hearing has been duly published in the Rupert Pioneer Record for the time required by law, and that the necessary Notice has been posted in three places within said herd district, of the time and place of hearing said petition, and that the affidavit of publication and the affidavit of posting of said notices having been duly filed with the Clerk of said Board; and it further appearing to the said Board that a majority of the qualified electors of said proposed herd district are in favor of the enforcement of the herd law therein, and that the granting of said petition would be beneficial to said district, and it further appearing to said Board that all things necessary and proper to be done for the creation of said herd District have been fully complied with, it is hereby;

ORDERED AND DECLARED, that the following described territory of Minidoka County, Idaho, is created a Herd District in accordance with said petition, as follows, to wit:

Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30 of Township Seven (7) South, Range twenty five (25) East of the Boise Meridian.

And that the following named animals, to wit: Horses, hogs, mules, cattle, sheep and goats are prohibited from running at large in said herd District during the entire twelve months of each year. This order shall be and continue in force and effect on and after the 15th day of June, 1914.



